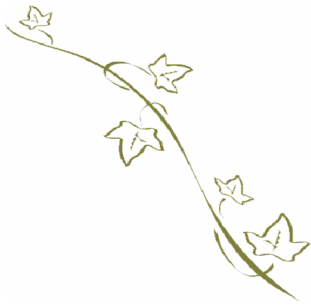

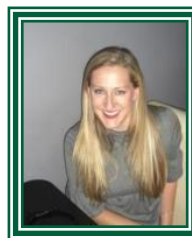

I believe in its high ideals that lift me up beyond myself.

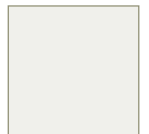
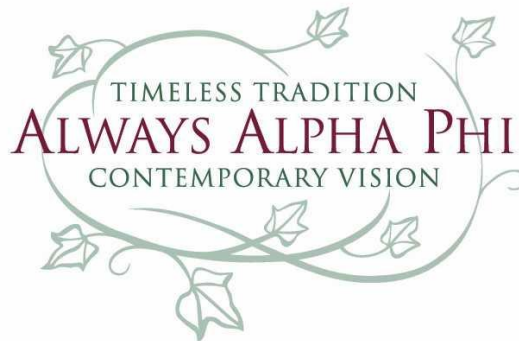
I believe in its earnest drive for good scholarship, moral character, and genuine culture.
